

Message from the President

It is indeed my pleasure to address members of the Indian Association of Cardiovascular Thoracic Anaesthesiologists as the President of the Society. Greetings from Kochi! I hope all my colleagues enjoyed a wonderful theme-oriented conference at Kochi. This was the third time that we were holding the conference in Kochi.

When taking over as the President, one of my primary intents was to ensure adequate representation of women in our society. Women anaesthesiologists are now slowly gaining the majority status among all anaesthesiologists in the country, and we, as cardiac anaesthesiologists, should not lag behind. We have a significant number of lady cardiac anaesthesiologists who are doing extremely well and leading the team in many institutes. As a woman, wife and mother, they do much more work than a male cardiac anaesthesiologist who often are dedicated only to their work, whereas a lady has to do multitasking, keeping home and office in order. In pursuit of this, we have already sent an opinion poll among the ladies in the society and before the next conference, will come up with a definite plan for women representation. It is also my humble request that in the coming elections for the next year we should encourage our female colleagues to stand for the various posts that are available.

Another area that has not made progress over the years has been the modifications in the bye laws. Changes in the bye laws, which has been approved by the GBM has not been registered over the years. As many of us are aware, since 2015, we have not registered any new bye law changes. Many changes have been adapted over the years by the GBM. The new committee will look into these changes and make appropriate changes in the original bye laws before registration. This team is also well into its work.

We had discussed the proposal that was given for being a part of the International Association of Cardiac Anaesthesiologists (IACA) at the last GBM. Some members felt that this could be a drain on the resources of the Society without added benefit and the proposal was discarded. However, as the President of the Society, I feel that it is high time that we cardiac anaesthesiologist be seen seriously by the world and this is an opportunity for us. A few new proposals have also been given by the IACA and it is my sincere request that we look into this matter again. We shall discuss this once again at the next GBM.



This newsletter has highlighted the awardees for the Lifetime Achievement Award for 2026 and the speakers chosen for the reputed PN Bhat and VA Punnoose orations for the upcoming conference at Vishakhapatnam in February 2026. The minutes of the GBM are also being circulated. The International and National Travelling Fellowships are also up for grabs and as seniors we should encourage our juniors to spend time at other reputed National and International Institutes, gain experience and knowledge and implement these changes at our own practise.

The team at Vizhag is strongly moving towards identifying the center for the conference and the Scientific Committee is similarly involved with the preparations for the next conference. We are hoping to see another wonderful conference in 2026.

Here's hoping that all cardiac anaesthesiologists do good work and have a great time.

Notification

- The FTEE theory exam was conducted on 25th May 2025 across six centers in India (Gurgaon, Mumbai, Kolkata, Chennai, Bengaluru, and Trivandrum). A total of 90 candidates from across the country had registered for the exam, of whom 84 took the exam. The number of successful candidates in the theory exam was 53, giving a pass percentage of 63.1%. The first practical exam is scheduled to be held from 1st to 3rd August 2025 at Vydehi Advanced Simulation Academy (VASA), Bengaluru. The last date for application is 30th June 2025.
- The dates for the FIACTA exit exam is 20th and 21st September 2025. The application form is enclosed and candidates who are eligible to appear for the exam may fill the form and send it to the ICCA Registrar email by 21st July 2025. The venues for the exit exams will be announced subsequently.
- Honorary FTEE and FIACTA applications are invited and the detailed forms are enclosed for perusal and needful. The last date to apply for the Honorary FTEE and FIACTA is 31st August 2025.
- The ICCA will be starting cardiovascular ultrasound course for non-cardiac anesthesiologists and other allied specialties within a short time. The modalities of the course are being finalized and further updates will be announced soon.

IACTA National / International Travel Fellowship

IACTA invites applications/nominations for travel fellowships from young anaesthesiologists. It carries an award of Rs 40,000/- for visiting a center of excellence in India and Rs 75,000/- for an overseas hospital/institute. The applicant can choose to visit a center within India (in a city other than the applicant's place of work) or overseas.

1. Total one Indian and one International travelling fellowship per year.

2. The center should perform at least 1,000 cardiac procedures annually or excel in performing a particular surgery/ procedure/technique.

3. The duration of the fellowship is normally one month.

4. The travel grant is awarded every year to a suitable candidate.

5. The applicant should be a life member of IACTA and have a minimum of two years of experience in cardiac anesthesia.

6. If working in a department, he/she should obtain approval from the head of the department. The acceptance letter from the center of the visit should be attached.

7. The applicant's age should be less than 40 years on the last date of application.

8. Application in the prescribed format should reach the IACTA office before 31st August 2025.

9. The IACTA office will scrutinize applications and finally approve them by EC and GBM.

10. The name of the anaesthesiologist selected will be announced during the GBM at the national conference of IACTA in February.

11. After completion of the observership, the anesthesiologist should submit a brief report to the IACTA.
