Exit Examination Protocol

The examination shall consist of the following parts: Theory and Practical (clinical examination & viva voce)

A) Theory: Duration: 3 hours Marks: 100

The question booklet contain 10 questions of 10 marks each. These will be subjective questions related to the curriculum as mentioned in ECMO course along with clinical case scenarios.

B) Clinical examination & Viva voce: total 400 marks

One long case viva: 100 marks Two short cases viva: 150 marks

Table viva 1: 50 marks: Instruments: ECMO console, Centrimag, Oxygenators, cannulae Hemofilters

Table viva 2: 50 marks: Drugs, ABG, TEG/ROTEM, X ray, Echocardiography, Ultrasound

Table viva 3: 50 marks: Log book, Scientific presentations, Publications: 50 marks

Logbook: The candidate should have a logbook with a minimum of **20 cases** and it should have a good mixture of all types of cases. Logbook should be signed by the supervisor and institute head.

Total marks (Theory + Practical) = 500 marks

Passing criteria: Candidates need to secure 50% marks in both theory and practical separately i.e. to pass, candidate must secure 50 or above out of 100 in theory and 200 or above out of 400 in practical.
