Greetings from IACTA Office.

It gives me immense pleasure to present the second newsletter of 2018 after the first sent in July, 2018.

The main contents of the news letter are the advertisement for various post of Executive Committee for which applications are invited. Apart from these, applications are invited for various fellowship programs, Janak Mehta award session and for 2021 annual conference of IACTA.

Since the publication of last news letter in July 2018, there has been a mid-term meeting of executive committee, ICCA board meeting and the activities have been at great pace regarding the decisions taken in these meetings and various subcommittees formed for important projects.

A. Advertisement for the Executive Council posts:

Applications are invited for the below given post of executive council of IACTA. Application properly filled by the applicants must reach IACTA office by 31st December 2018 at IACTA Office. The last date of withdrawal of nominations is 20th January 2019 for all above posts.

E. Application for Chief Editor, IACTA Echo Library www.iactaecholibrary.co.in:

Applications are invited for the post of "Chief Editor IACTA Echo Library". Though the criteria are for the same are given on website but as this is the initial phase of development of echo library, the EC has recommended to relax the criteria and the best suitable applicant will be selected. All applicants should send their application to secretary, IACTA and attach their academic work related to echocardiography. The applications should reach the IACTA office by 31.12.2018 and he EC will take the final decision on selection of the new Chief Editor. Till that time, present editor, Dr. Rajesh Arya has been asked to continue.

Meanwhile, the frequency of the weekly manuscript (published on Saturday) has been reduced from every week to every alternate week. The mid-week quiz is published as routine on every Tuesday. The Echo Library membership has increased more than 3500 worldwide. The hit count on website is more than 46000 showing steady growth. The proposal of dedicating four pages of ACA for manuscript published at echo library was agreed by the Chief editor ACA and was approved by EC.

Major activities since last newsletter in July'2018:

Endorsement of various regional conferences:

Endorsement of various guidelines:

Following guidelines have been endorsed by IACTA:

- A. "Indian Cardio-pulmonary Guidelines", issued under the aegis of Resuscitation Council and published in Nov. 2017 issue of Indian Journal of Anaesthesia.
- B. "Guidelines for Performing a Comprehensive Transesophageal Echocardiographic Examination in Children and All Patients with Congenital Heart Disease", prepared by American Society of Echocardiography.

Indian College of Cardiac Anaesthesia (ICCA):

Indian College of Cardiac Anaesthesia had their meeting on 28.07.2018 at Kolkata where the progress of the issues related to ICCA were discussed headed by Dr. Deepak Tempe (Chancellor), Dr. Suresh Nair (Vice Chancellor), Dr. Thomas Koshy (Registrar) and other board members. All the revised protocols related to FIACTA and FTEE exams have been laid down and are available on IACTA website under the ICCA column. Guidelines for FIACTA center recognition, criteria for FIACTA and FTEE teachers and examiners and the protocol to be followed for them have been described and the related forms are available on website for download. Interested persons should apply and send the application forms with required documents to ICCA office (iccaregistrar@gmail.com) with a copy to IACTA office (iactasecretariat@gmail.com).

IACTA Website www.iacta.co.in:

Attempts are made to give a new look to the IACTA website aiming that this looks more informative and appears as an academic body's website. The payment gateway has been taken with CC avenue and has been incorporated in the website for all online payments. It is planned that all forms and communication with IACTA can be done through website. Efforts are put to make the system more efficient, transparent and user friendly. In an attempt for this, we are starting phase I changes.

Phase I: Following steps are taken in first phase starting of upgradation of IACTA website:

- a. All present IACTA member's profile is being created on website and the login details for their profile will be sent to them by personalized email mentioning their user ID and password.
- b. Communication should be done through the profile login. Please update the required fields in your profile.
- c. It is planned that from 01.01.2019, the new membership can be applied through website and there would not be any need to send papers by surface mail. After filling the details in online membership form and attaching the desired documents, the new applicant can make the payment through website. Final approval of membership will be by IACTA office and the same will be informed to the applicant with all membership details through the autogenerated email system.

After this first phase of member login portal and new membership registration, all exam related activities i.e. application for various exams, fee payment, the communication from exam controllers and the result of the exam will be done through the website.

However, for the smooth transition from hard copy to e-communication, both the methods will function during the transition phase. Once the e-communication is smooth, gradually we shall shift to paperless office.

Mid-term meeting of Executive committee:

Mid-term meeting of Executive committee was held on 29.07.2018 at Kolkata and was presided over by President IACTA. Following issues were discussed and decision taken in the meeting:

- a) Awards and orations:
 - Lifetime achievement award for 2019: Dr. Alka Mandke
 - Dr. V.A Punnoose oration: Dr. R. Gopinath
 - Dr. P. N. Bhatt oration: **Dr. Mukul Kapoor**
- b) Inclusion of outgoing treasurer as EC members for one year (as the office of secretary/treasurer are changed every three years).
- c) EC was informed by previous secretary that the long-standing issue of our IT case regarding 12A and 80G has been decided and our council Mr. Rahul Khare has sent us the copy of judgement that the IT department has referred the issue and the verdict is in our favor.
- d) Payment gateway on IACTA website is active now.
- e) Chief Editor, Annals of Cardiac Anaesthesia presented the progress of ACA since he took over. The financial issue related to mobile APP of ACA remains unresolved. The legal notice received by Chief Editor, ACA has been legally replied through an advocate.
- f) FATE workshop and Golden FATE contest: These have been conducted as pilot project in Pune and Hyderabad conferences. A "Golden Fate Committee" headed by Dr. Sandeep Mutha is formed to look into the future conduct of these events as a regular activity of IACTA. The report of the committee shall be presented to GBM (FATE Committee)
- g) Professional group insurance scheme: A proposal of having professional insurance scheme for IACTA members was presented. After discussion, a "Professional Insurance Committee" was formed headed by Dr. Vipul Sharma. The report of the committee will be presented to the GBM. (Professional Insurance Scheme Committee).
- h) IACTA research fund: A proposal of creating research fund was presented. The President constituted a "Research Fund Committee" headed by Dr Prabhat Tiwari. The committee's report will be presented to EC and then to subsequent GBM. (Research Fund Committee)
- i) Report on regional branches of IACTA was sent by the coordinator Dr. Harish Babu. One more regional branch has been formed i.e. Society of Cardiac Anaesthesia, Nagpur (SCAN) which has members from Vidarbha area of Maharashtra. Thus, IACTA has now total 14 regional/state/city branches.
- j) IACTA reform committee: Reform committee headed by Dr. P.K Neema presented the recommendations related to issues addressed to the committee. The detailed report will be presented to GBM at Kolkata. Certain important issues related to selection criteria and procedure for different posts of ICCA and conduct of conference are under consideration of reform committee. The recommendations as submitted will be discussed in EC meeting and finally presented to GBM.

Obituary: IACTA lost one of the seniors most cardiac anaesthesiologist and pioneer of cardiac anaesthesia, Dr. Paritosh Mazumdar. Dr. Mazumdar was one of the first few anaesthesiologists who took up the challenge of venturing into the field of Cardiac Anaesthesia and Critical Care in India. For his contribution in development of the "Chitra Valve", he was awarded the "International Scholar of the Highest Standards" by the Cleveland Clinic Foundation; USA in 1980. IACTA offers condolences and

prayers for him. IACTA will always remain indebted to the contributions to cardiac anaesthesia made by Dr. Paritosh Mazumdar.
